ALERT arrests Sylvan Lake man on child pornography charges

Sylvan Lake...Alberta Law Enforcement Response Teams' integrated child exploitation unit (ICE), in cooperation with Sylvan Lake RCMP detachment, laid a total of four charges against a Sylvan Lake man relating to child pornography.

Investigators allege the accused, Andrew John TETTERSEL, 33, was in possession of and made child pornography available on the Internet.

He was arrested last Wednesday and charged with possession of child pornography, accessing child pornography, making child pornography available and making child pornography.

TETTERSEL is not currently in custody but has been placed under a number of court conditions including not to have contact with any child under the age of 16 years, not to have access to a computer, and not to have access to the Internet. He is scheduled to appear in Red Deer Provincial court on January 14, 2011.

The investigation is ongoing and no further details will be released at this time.

ICE investigates the sexual exploitation of children through the Internet and works to reduce harm through public education and prevention programs.

ALERT is an umbrella organization established by the Government of Alberta to bring together the province's most sophisticated law enforcement resources to tackle serious and organized crime. Close to 400 municipal police, RCMP and sheriffs work for ALERT.
