Calgary man charged with child pornography offences

Calgary... The Southern Alberta Internet Child Exploitation (ICE) Unit, in collaboration with an undercover operation led by the FBI - Philadelphia Division, have arrested a Calgary resident and charged him with several child pornography offences.

Roderick "Kyle" Janssen, 35, has been charged with possession of child pornography, accessing child pornography, making child pornography, and distributing child pornography. Additional charges are pending.

Staff Sergeant Steve Lorne is available to answer any inquiries from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Wednesday, April 13. His contact number is 403-428-4901.

He was arrested on Tuesday, April 12, and remains in custody.

The investigation is ongoing and no further details will be released at this time.

ICE investigates the sexual exploitation of children through the Internet and works to reduce harm through public education and prevention programs.

ALERT is an umbrella organization established by the Government of Alberta to bring together the province's most sophisticated law enforcement resources to tackle serious and organized crime. Close to 400 municipal police, RCMP and sheriffs work for ALERT.
