## Additional charges laid against former Sylvan Lake man

*Red Deer...* Alberta Law Enforcement Response Team's Internet Child Exploitation Unit (ICE), in cooperation with the Red Deer RCMP Detachment, conducted a follow-up investigation on a former Sylvan Lake resident, Andrew John TETTERSEL, in relation to child pornography offences.

Forensic examination of TETTERSEL's electronic storage devices indicated that an additional investigation was warranted. Subsequently, TETTERSEL has been charged with sexual assault and sexual interference of a person under the age of 14 years. The victim has been identified.

TETTERSEL is currently remanded in custody and will appear in Red Deer court on April 21, 2011.

ICE investigates the sexual exploitation of children through the Internet and works to reduce harm through public education and prevention programs.

ALERT is an umbrella organization established by the Government of Alberta to bring together the province's most sophisticated law enforcement resources to tackle serious and organized crime. Close to 400 municipal police, RCMP and sheriffs work for ALERT.

*Background (Released on Nov. 15, 2010):* Alberta Law Enforcement Response Teams' Integrated Child Exploitation unit (ICE), in cooperation with Sylvan Lake RCMP detachment, laid four charges against Andrew John TETTERSEL, 33, of Sylvan Lake: possession of child pornography, accessing child pornography, making child pornography, and distributing child pornography.
