## Online investigation leads to child pornography charges

Calgary... On April 28, 2011, the Alberta Law Enforcement Response Team's Internet Child Exploitation Unit (ICE) concluded an online child pornography investigation with the arrest of a Calgary man.

The arrest came after Southern Alberta ICE Unit initiated an online investigation that resulted in a search warrant being executed on a Calgary residence. Computers and other electronic devices were seized for further forensic examination.

**Christopher SHELTON, 29**, has been charged with possession of child pornography, accessing child pornography, and making available child pornography.

ICE investigates the sexual exploitation of children through the Internet and works to reduce harm through public education and prevention programs.
